Please be sure to completely read the information letter from Super Summer because there is important information you need to know concerning Super Summer this year...like dress code, schedule changes, and venue reassignments due to the construction at OBU. This is a leadership camp and as leaders of our student ministry you represent our church and are expected to obey and follow the guidelines presented in this letter as well as any rules given to you during the orientation on Monday, June 8th the day you arrive at camp.

Madison Spieker, our summer intern, Hunter Hanrahan (TL), and I will be leaving for Super Summer on Saturday, June 6th to prepare and setup for the students we will be leading during the week. Staci Wilson will be transporting you to camp on Monday, June 8th and will be taking the church people mover. If you have questions concerning Super Summer, Stacey's cell phone number is 580.471.7461. You will need to arrive at the church at 9 am to check in, load up , and leave at 9:30am. You will be stopping to eat in OKC or Shawnee (whichever you guys decide on) so you will need money to pay for your lunch. Student onsite registration/orientation for Super Summer is scheduled from 1:30-2:30pm, I will help get you where you need to be for registration. Once you get your dorm assignments and have checked in at your school booth, you will be directed where to pick up your dorm key then get your belongings and get settled in your dorm. At 3:30pm all students must meet back at the RAWC for Orientation. Following orientation, we will have supper together (4:30-5:45pm) with our FBC Sayre group so that I can answer any questions you may have. Your first session in your school will begin Monday night at 5:50 pm. Begin preparing your heart by spending time in prayer, asking God to speak to you and to prepare you for this awesome week. IT'S ALMOST CAMP TIME. 🙌🙌 The countdown is officially on and we can't wait to see what God has in store for Super Summer 2026. Before we get there, let's hit a few important reminders so you can show up ready.

Worship Location & Campus Updates

Once again, nightly worship will be held in the RAWC at Oklahoma Baptist University. OBU is still hard at work renovating Raley Chapel, and honestly... the construction site somehow looks even bigger this year. At this point we're pretty sure they're building the Death Star. Even though camp may look a little different this summer, we're thankful OBU continues making space for us to gather together. We're praying for their campus and all the work being done there.

Construction Site Safety

One very important reminder this year: OBU's construction work will still be active while we are on campus. The construction areas have been clearly fenced off, marked, and are completely off limits to students. Please do not treat the construction site like a challenge course, a shortcut, a hiding place, or your personal Minecraft server. For everyone's safety, any student who enters the construction area or messes with the worksite in any way will be sent home immediately. This isn't us trying to kill the fun — there will already be plenty of that at camp. We simply want to make sure every student stays safe while construction crews continue working.

Registration & Arrival

Student registration will take place Monday from 1:30–2:30 PM. You'll check in at the RAWC with your church group. After registration, your church leader will receive your camp ID card, which you'll need throughout the week. Please do not carry luggage through registration. Due to construction and limited space, luggage will need to be unloaded separately in designated parking areas before registration begins. Trust us — dragging three duffel bags, a pillow pet, and a snack crate through check-in is not the spiritual gift you think it is.

No Visitor Policy

Super Summer has a no outside visitor policy during camp week. Because of our worship relocation and centralized evening gathering spaces, outside visitors will not be allowed on campus during the week. Thanks for helping us keep camp safe, focused, and distraction free.

Dress Code Reminder

Campers, don't forget to review the dress code while packing! Shorts must be fingertip length. Skirts and dresses must be no shorter than four inches from the knee. Tank tops need to fully

cover shoulders, having no large armholes. Please avoid visible undergarments, tight-fitting clothes, and rips above fingertip shorts or jeans. Let's try to avoid pajama-level laziness in public areas, as well. As always, butts should remain inside the pants God blessed you with.

Food Delivery Policy

Food delivery services are not allowed during camp. This means no DoorDash, UberEats, and no "my cousin is just dropping something off real quick." Food delivered to campus will not be given to the student who ordered it and will, instead, be consumed by exec staff. Your generosity will not be forgotten.

Super Summer Gives Back Offering

When packing spending money, don't forget about the offering! For the past three years, this offering has helped send Super Summer students on mission around the world. Every dollar helps advance the Kingdom of God and support students pursuing ministry opportunities. God uses generous people to do incredible things.

Don't Forget To Pack:

Come prepared with a Bible, pen and notebook. Note-takers are history-makers! Twin-size bedding, toiletries for a full week and possibly an air mattress if needed. Optional items like bug spray and snacks to share are a great idea, too! You might also want some spending cash for must-haves around the campus.

Final Reminder

Campers are expected to remain on campus for the entire week unless there is a medical emergency or a pre-approved exception from the Week Coordinator. Camp concludes Friday at 11:15 AM, and students are expected to help clean and move out of dorms before leaving. Leaving early is considered an early departure.
